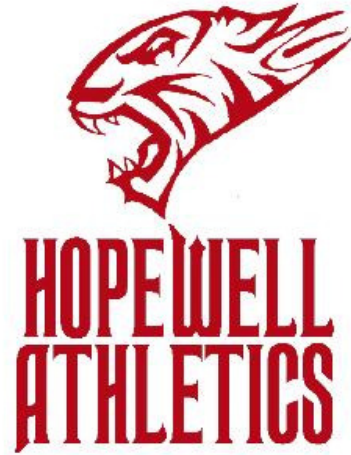

Academic Eligibility:

1. To remain eligible, all Student Athletes must be making adequate academic progress towards graduation.
2. Student Athletes must meet all requirements for Hopewell Academy to be eligible for the Fall Semester teams including adequate progress in all core classes and completion of adequate number of credit hours.
3. Students must not have been convicted of a felony or adjudicated as a delinquent for an offense that could have been considered a felony committed by an adult in this state or any state.
4. The coaching staff will be working with the teachers to ensure success in and outside of the classroom. Periodical checks will be administered throughout the year.

Attendance Eligibility:

1. Student athletes must attend at least 1/2 day in order to participate in practice of contest. Students must have written doctors notices for excused absences.
2. If the athlete must miss the 1/2 day it must be an excused absence
3. Students must be properly enrolled in Hopewell Academy at the time of participation.

Physicals and Release Forms:

1. Hopewell does not have an Insurance Policy in place for its students that participate in athletics. Please make sure your family policy provides coverage for sports participations
2. Allergies, Illnesses and Medicines: Be sure your Student Emergency Card is up to date and current throughout the year. In the event your child is injured Hopewell consults that form first.
3. All students must have a signed Waiver on file before being able to tryout or practice for the sport.
4. All students must have a completed Physical Form on file.
5. Physicals are good for 365 days.
6. A new Waiver form and Physical Form must be completed every year.
7. Let the Athletic Director know if your child turns 19 on or before October 16
